

Course Information - 2017

Sage Aged Care Worker Program

This program is delivered full-time and encompasses the following courses:

- CHC43015 Certificate IV in Ageing Support
- First Aid (HLTAID003 Provide first aid)
- Leisure & Lifestyle Programming (CHCSS00080 Induction to Leisure and Health Skill Set)

Applications are accepted throughout the year, and all applicants are required to participate in a selection interview to determine their eligibility for enrolment. Sage has programs commencing every month across its campuses, and students can elect to study during the day on weekdays, or in the evenings and at weekends.

The program is delivered in a blended mode with on-campus sessions and online lessons, and the typical student completes the program in 1-2 years. Students generally complete around 15 contact hours per week for classes, and can attend additional tutorial sessions. Students should also set aside up to 15 hours per week for personal study time. Assessment types vary, but can include practical demonstrations, projects, written questions, case studies and workplace hours.

Through program attendance and participation, completion of all program activities including a minimum of 120 hours of industry work placement and successful completion of all assessments tasks, students will attain the following competencies:
